

Minister Robert L. Jones, Sr., M.S.Ed., M.Div.

A native of Norfolk, Virginia and is the fourth child of eleven children. His parents are James H. Jones, Jr. from Currituck, North Carolina and Catherine Isaac Jones from Springfield, South Carolina. His mother was his first Bible Study teacher and minister. Additionally, he has served as Youth Sunday School teacher and has provided servant-leadership as the founding Chair Emeritus of the Ministry of Men on the M.O.V.E. (2004 – 2008) at Mount Gilead Missionary Baptist Church (MGMBC). At MGMBC, where he was licensed to preach the gospel on January 24, 2007 under the prophetic leadership of Rev. Dr. Shelton Murphy, Pastor, he is an Associate Minister and serves in various ministerial capacities. He has completed his first unit of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) toward Board Certification as a Chaplain, under the esteemed spiritual leadership development of Rev.
